WINE TASTINGS AND PAIRINGS

The first vine plantings of Chenin Blanc and Pinotage were made in the late 1960's. The neighbouring wine farms bought the fruit from our vines until the late 1990's, which was then the birth of our Sylvanvale Vineyards collection and the maiden vintages were made in 1998. SylvanVale Vineyards is well known for making the first single red cultivar Rose, the Pinotage Rose.

Today these are some of the flagship vineyards in the Devon Valley, and the south-east facing slopes with their rich red soils now produce superb Pinotage, Cabernet and Chenin Blanc cultivars. Generations of Stellenbosch residents have fond memories of enjoying a drink or a meal while sitting on the hotel terrace overlooking the vineyards.

Today the Devon Valley Hotel has a Sylvanvale and Ghost Tree collection:

Our SylvanVale collection:

'Sylvan' is an Anglo Saxon word which translates to "A Cluster of Trees", and 'Vale' also means valley. Simply put SylvanVale refers to a "Valley of Trees".



GHOST TREE COLLECTION

This collection is our secondary label and initially intended for exports. The name comes from a cluster of Box Elder trees which lose all their leaves in winter and thus look like skeleton tendrils. Our tastings are done at The Devon Valley Hotel, either on the Vineyard Terrace or in winter in the cosy Cedarwood Lounge by the fireplace.

GIN TASTINGS

In the past years gin has become increasingly popular and the Devon Valley Hotel has taken the opportunity to showcase the best locally made gins in a wonderful tasting experience. It is well-known that gin was used as an herbal medicine in the Middle Ages.

No two gins are alike, and the taste is influenced by the botanicals used in the distilling process.

The Devon Valley Hotel showcases:

Cruxland gin, a 100% pure grape gin is served with ginger ale, star anise and thyme.

Wixworth gin, permeated with the finest traditional botanicals is served with cucumber, fresh fennel, a crack of black pepper and pink tonic.

Blaauklippen Triple African Botanicals gin, infused with buchu and rooibos herbs is served with rosemary, Hibiscus Tonic and dried cranberries.

Cape Town Rooibos gin with an earthy, slightly sweet and nutty flavor of the Rooibos is served with ginger ale, orange zest and mint.

WHISKEY TASTINGS

The Cedarwood Lounge & Bar is home to one of the most definitive collections of Single Malt Scotch Whiskies in South Africa and is frequented by self-confessed whisky lovers from all over the globe. Whiskey also originated and was used as a medicine and is made by fermenting grain mash. The signature "Single Malt" title is derived when a whiskey has been distilled at a single distillery and bottled from a mash of malted grains from a single distillery.

Highland Park, known for its aromatic notes is paired with panko prawn and homemade sweet chili sauce.

Balvenie 14 Year, a 14-year-old limited edition and known for its vanilla and toffee notes is paired with chorizo and candied apple.

Auchentoshan Three Wood, known for its sweet fruity notes is paired with millionaire's shortbread.

Laphroaig 10 Year holds clove, ginger peel and vanilla pod aromas and is paired with candied pecan nuts.

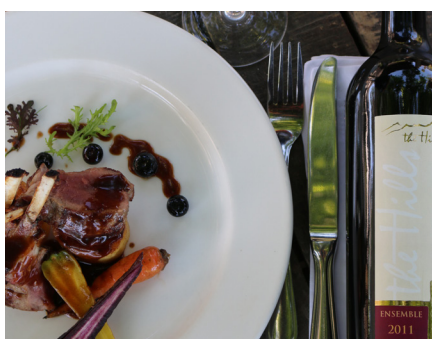

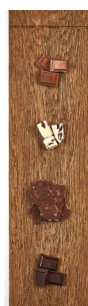
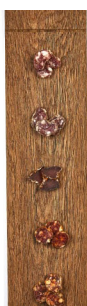

Dorp Street is the second oldest road in South Africa and originally formed part of the old wagon road to Cape Town. Take a stroll and admire the historically rich road - from old buildings and gables with a variety of architectural styles from Cape Dutch to Victorian, lots of restaurants, cafes and a hotel or two, and the famous Oom Samie se Winkel which is a must stop!

Church street, which is right next to Dorp Street is lined with ancient oak trees that have been declared national monuments. This bustling street is filled with interesting art galleries, charming restaurants and coffee shops.

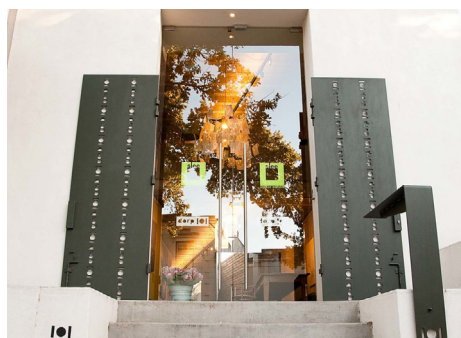
ADVENTURE SHOP BIKE AND EBIKE TOURS
